

2021 OKFQHR HORSE SENSE

Beginner Class Definition – Truly new rider with no prior riding or showing experience.

Cutting vs. Herd Work – Cutting needs you to keep your hand down where Herd Work allows you to help your horse.

Working Cow Horse Level 1 – Perform the pattern in the book which is a dry pattern with 2 cones. The cow portion involves **boxing** on one end only for 45 seconds. Horse cannot have gone down the fence before. Horses 3-5 can show Open only this year with this Club.

Working Cow Horse Level 2 – Perform the pattern in the book which is a dry pattern with 2 cones. The cow portion involves **box-drive-box** with a 90 second time limit from the time the cow is released, however if the Judge feels the cow portion has been satisfactorily completed a whistle may be blown. Horse cannot have gone down the fence before. Horses 3-5 can show Open only this year with this Club.

Working Cow Horse Level 3 – Tradition working cow horse consisting of boxing, taking the cow down the fence and circle the cow both ways.

Working Ranch Horse Level 1 - Perform the pattern in the book including removing bridle, lifting feet, ground tie, dismount and remounting in no particular order. The cow portion consists of **boxing** on one end only for 45 seconds. Horse cannot have gone down the fence before.

Working Ranch Horse Level 2 - Perform the pattern in the book including removing bridle, lifting feet, ground tie, dismount and remounting in no particular order. The cow portion consists of **box-drive-box for 90 seconds**; however, be aware of a 4 minute time limit overall for both portions. Horse cannot have gone down the fence before.

Working Ranch Horse Level 3 - Perform the pattern in the book including removing bridle, lifting feet, ground tie, dismount and remounting in no particular order. The cow portion consists of boxing, taking the cow down the fence and turning then roping the cow (Breakaway honda + 2 loops).
